ENTRANT AGREEMENT:

I, the undersigned artist, hereby declare my intention to exhibit my artwork, as described in my SlideRoom entry form, at GoggleWorks, Reading, PA. If selected, submitted artwork is to be delivered **on March 12 and remain until April 28, 2019**. I hereby represent that I am the owner of the artwork being submitted by me both as to the artwork's physical manifestation and the copyright of my artwork. I accept full responsibility for any and all damage, loss, theft and/or any other casualty of any kind to my artwork in transit to and from GoggleWorks. I hereby waive any and all claims I may have against GoggleWorks, its employees, officers, directors and committee personnel and the Artists Equity Board of Directors. I understand that my work, if selected, may not be hung if it fails to meet minimum professional presentation standards or arrives damaged. By entering the Artists Equity 2019 70th Anniversary Members' Juried Exhibition, I understand and agree to all conditions set forth in this prospectus. **Submission of work via the SlideRoom website constitutes an entrant's authorized signature.**

ELIGIBILITY: All members of Philadelphia Tri-State Artists Equity (AE) are eligible. Our records must show that your membership dues are current in order to participate. There is never an entry fee for AE exhibits. Visit www.artistsequity.org for a membership application.

New members are welcome to submit; however, if you are not a current AE member you must contact the exhibition chair to begin the membership process by January 28, 2019 in order to submit work via SlideRoom.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: You will be notified of acceptance by email or phone the week of February 25, 2019.

SALES: GoggleWorks will process all retail sales of AE artwork, and will retain 35% of retail sales for all work sold.

PUBLICITY: Unless otherwise specified, AE and GoggleWorks reserve the right to reproduce work for the purposes of promoting this and future exhibits.

Click on the **Directory** option to access our current program "**2019 AE 70th Anniversary Members' Juried Exhibition.**" Follow the step by step instructions provided by SlideRoom and/or visit our website for detailed directions for submitting your artwork. Please submit digital photo images (as jpegs) that are no larger than 5 MB (**NOTE:** pixels and size in inches do not matter though SlideRoom

recommends that digital files fit within 1280 X 1280X 72 dpi as a guide). Each artist may submit up to two works to the site. **If you experience technical difficulties, send email to support@slideroom.com.**

SlideRoom entry deadline: Midnight February 10, 2019

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS: Painting, photography, sculpture, works on paper, mixed media and fabric art are eligible. Work must be recent and not have been exhibited previously in any AE exhibit. 2D work must be professionally presented, properly prepared for hanging and dry. Works may not exceed four feet (4' or 48") in width including the frame. No clip frames or unframes are permitted. 3D work must be sturdy and stable. Artists are responsible for supplying their own floor pedestals for 3D work.

AE and GoggleWorks reserve the right to reject any entries that do not meet specified requirements. Dangerous, damaged or poorly prepared work will not be accepted. No late entries. Accepted work must remain for the duration of the exhibition. **ALL WORK MUST BE PICKED UP NO LATER THAN 5:00 PM April 28, 2019.**

Neysa Grassi is a faculty critic in PAFA's Post Baccalaureate and MFA programs. A graduate of PAFA's Certificate program, she has won numerous awards, including a Pew Fellowship in the Arts, a Works on Paper Fellowship from the Ballinglen Arts Foundation in Ireland and a Residency Award from the Fundación Valparaíso in Mojácar, Spain.

Grassi is currently represented by Locks Gallery in Philadelphia, where she has had numerous solo exhibitions. She has also exhibited at the University of Delaware, Moore College of Art and Design, Swarthmore College, The Susquehanna Art Museum and the Pensacola Museum of Art. Her work is represented in collections of the Philadelphia Museum of Art, The Palmer Museum of Art at Penn State University and the Blue Cross of Pennsylvania.

Grassi is a Critic in the Post-Baccalaureate and MFA program. She also teaches courses in the Continuing Education program.
